

EPSDT and Title V Collaboration to Improve Child Health

Advocacy Strategies for Improving EPSDT Performance

Connecticut

The Children's Health Council in Connecticut has developed and implemented a tracking and performance monitoring program aimed at increasing EPSDT participation. "EPSDT On-Time Visit Rates" (an estimate of the screening rates for individual children enrolled in Medicaid managed care) are calculated monthly and reported quarterly to the Department of Social Services by age and by health plan.
